BEDC Bylaws

- At its regularly scheduled meeting on April 15, 2025, the BEDC Board of Directors approved a First Amendment to Article II of its bylaws.
- Amendment clarifies the eligibility of governing body members to continue serving on the BEDC Board if they do not seek, or are not re-elected to, a new term.
- Specifically allows such members to hold over through the end of their BEDC term, provided both terms conclude within the same calendar year.
