Discuss and consider action: Purchase of three Knox MedVaults for the Fire Department:

Information

The Fire Department currently uses three Knox MedVault secure storage units, which are designed to safely store and manage access to controlled substances, such as narcotics, in emergency medical services (EMS) settings. These existing units have reached the end of their service life and are no longer compatible with the current web-based platform, making it difficult to meet compliance with regulatory requirements.

The Fire Department is requesting to purchase three replacement units that will provide secure access control, audit trails, and network connectivity to support remote management and monitoring.

The new units will be installed in the medical supply storage room to enhance the security of controlled substances, reduce the risk of unauthorized access, and ensure continued compliance with regulatory standards.

Fiscal Impact

The total cost for the purchase of the new MedVaults is \$7,617.00.

Recommendation

Staff recommends approval of the purchase of three Knox MedVaults.
