ORDINANCE NO. 2025-32

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BURNET, TEXAS, EXTENDING THE DECLARATION OF A LOCAL STATE OF DISASTER RESULTING FROM EXTREME FLOODING; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, on July 6, 2025, the Mayor Pro Tem issued a proclamation declaring a state of disaster for the City of Burnet resulting from

extreme flooding throughout the City of Burnet, especially in areas along Hamilton Creek, as well as other creeks and low-lying areas around the City, and;

WHEREAS, the conditions necessitating declaration of a state of disaster continue to exist and is of such severity and magnitude that an effective response is beyond the capability of the City of Burnet to control; and

WHEREAS, §418.108(b) of the Texas Government Code provides that a local state of disaster may not be continued for a period of excess of seven days without the consent of the governing body of the political subdivision;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BURNET, TEXAS:

- 1. That the state of disaster proclaimed for the City of Burnet by the Mayor Pro Tem on July 6, 2025, shall continue until terminated by order of the City Council.
- 2. This ordinance is passed as an emergency measure and pursuant to local authority for emergency measures and shall become effective on the 13th day of July, 2025.
