

NE 3rd Avenue Trailhead Improvements Project Summary

Project Type: Park Improvement Total Project Cost: \$1,198,540

Construction Timeline: March 2024 - November 2025



Project Description

This project consisted in trailhead amenity improvements at the south end of the existing 3rd Avenue Trail. The project work included construction of a paved parking lot with ADA parking (25 stalls total), installation of a pre-manufactured restroom, wood seating on low gabion walls, picnic area, stormwater facility, updated entrance gate for accessibility, park signage and other furnishings.

Project Details and Benefits

- The unmarked gravel parking lot was uneven and hard to maintain.
- New parking and sidewalks benefit all patrons, including those with mobility issues.
- New restroom with water fountain is a great upgrade for all citizens that use Lacamas Lake Trail System.
- Stormwater facility treats parking lot runoff preventing contaminants to enter Lacamas Creek.
