County concurrency staff has reviewed the proposed Camas Business Center Traffic Impact Analysis dated November 11, 2021, prepared by Heath & Associates, Inc.

County staff's review of the applicant's traffic study found that the proposed land use is not expected to send 5, or more, peak hour trips to the county's regionally significant intersections and/or corridors. Because of this, county concurrency has no further comments and requires no further county concurrency related analysis.
