### Project Description

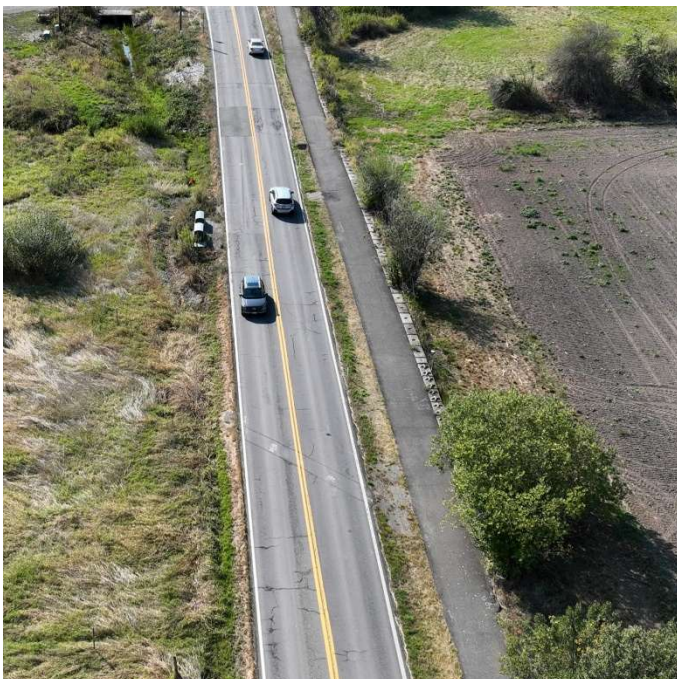
Grant funding for engineering design, right-of-way and construction was obtained through the WSDOT Surface Transportation Program (STPUL) and the Washington State Transportation Improvement Board. The project reconstructed a minor arterial roadway and constructed pedestrian and bicycle safety improvements between NW Parker Street and Grass Valley Park.

### Project Details and Benefits

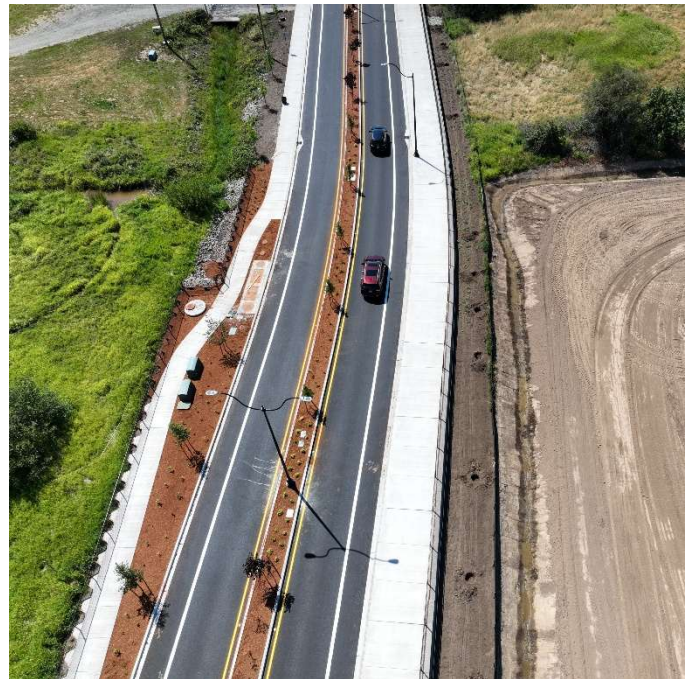
- Reconstructed 2,400 feet of minor-arterial roadway
- Constructed sidewalk, multi-use path, lighted pedestrian crossing, bicycle lanes, curb ramps, landscaping and irrigation, signing, striping, street lighting and stormwater improvements
- Completed the final section in the NW 38<sup>th</sup> Ave. corridor between Camas and Vancouver
