6. Complete thorough recordation, cataloguing, photography, identification, and classification of any artifacts. Include this information in the final report.
7. If human remains are encountered, stop work, secure the area, notify the county medical examiner, police, DAHP, & affected Tribes per RCW 27.44.055.
8. Notify DAHP and affected tribes immediately if any highly unusual discoveries are made.
