Thank you for the opportunity to comment on the Determination of Non-Significance (DNS) for SUB25-1010 Olive Terrace Subdivision within the city of Camas, section 35 of township 02 North, Range 03 East. We have reviewed the DNS and Environmental Checklist and have the following initial comment.

As indicated in the Environmental Checklist trees exist on site and will be removed from the site. If merchantable timber is removed/harvested as part of the proposal or future development, a Forest Practices Application will be required (RCW 76.09 and WAC 222). The FPA will need to meet the requirements of the Forest Practices Act and its rules. If the applicant would like to meet on-site with our local Forest Practices Forester, call our Pacific Cascade Region office at (360) 577-2025.
