2020 Citywide Pavement Preservation Slurry Seals

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INTRODUCTION: In 2018, the City of Camas awarded Blackline, Inc. the bid to complete slurry seals throughout the city. Operating under the Grounds Equipment Maintenance (GEM) interlocal agreement, this was a joint bid and award with the City of Vancouver. Under the bid framework, both cities had the option of renewing the contract with Blackline, Inc. for a period of up to two years, expiring on July 23, 2021. The joint contract provided both agencies the opportunity for savings with increased bid quantities, regional mobilization, and competitive pricing with multiple contractors bidding.

City staff prepared the 2020 Slurry Seal list and provided to Blackline, Inc. to bid the work based on the 2018 contract documents. Attached is a map showing the roads to be included in the work, the proposed contract, and original bid documents.

BUDGET IMPACT: Extension of the original contract will continue to provide favorable pricing with minor quantity increases for inflation and prevailing wage rates for a total cost of \$165,798.25. There is sufficient funds in the 2020 Pavement Preservation budget to complete the work.

ACTION REQUESTED: Approve the contract with Blackline, Inc. in the amount of \$165,798.25 for the 2020 Slurry Seal project.
