-client stated there was no PA at the facility, and they did not see a nurse while they were there

-another client was put on Librium and then it was stopped without proper tapering

Dear City of Camas,

As a Nurse of 25 years (23 years as an Intensive Care Nurse), I have some serious concerns with the newly proposed Rehab facility slated to open next to Dorothy Fox and Dorothy Fox Elementary School. I am a medical surgical intensive care nurse with direct experience working in an acute care setting with patients suffering from the effects of drug and alcohol abuse.

With this experience, I am compelled to ask the following questions that are concerning to me:

- 1. Why the need for such frequent patient monitoring? Monitoring that is performed every 30 minutes around the clock is only seen in patients that are actively withdrawing from drugs/alcohol in a hospital setting or are on a suicide watch. This type of care is what is seen in acute care settings, and then for only certain types of high-acuity patients.
- 2. Why the need to have cameras installed throughout the center and monitored throughout the day? If there are safety concerns, then having this facility share a fence with Dorothy Fox Elementary School and Dorothy Fox park is very worrisome. The safety of our school children is top priority.
- 3. When withdrawing from alcohol/drugs patients can become agitated, which can lead to violent behavior. At times confusion can be seen with some of these patients. Rehab facilities have limitations to treatment. At times patients have to be sent to a facility that is able to safely treat them. This can happen at any time day or night. Will a very limited number of staff (2 on night shift) be able to care for these types of patients? This does not seem adequate according to my experience.
- 4. Staff, at times, will not be able to make it to work for various reasons. Getting a replacement can be very difficult. On the night shift that will leave one staff to care for 15 patients.
- 5. There is a higher incidence of people with drug addictions that also suffer from other types of co-occurring addiction disorders and mental illness. Discover Recovery's own website states "studies have shown that about half the people with substance use disorders also suffer from mental illness." The stress from the withdrawal process could exacerbate these mental illnesses, potentially leading to unsafe behaviors. Of course, this won't be every patient, but the high turn-over rate of patients going through such a facility definitely exposes our community to a significantly increased probability.

6. If a patient chooses to leave the facility premises, they can do so. Staff will not be able to force a patient to remain if that patient decides to leave.

CUP 21-01: Supplemental Comments Submitted on Behalf of The Dorothy Fox Safety Alliance

<u>Highlighted Incidents Where Discover Recovery Patients Leave Facility</u> Unattended, Unaccompanied and Against Medical Advice

When carefully evaluating whether the proposed use in CUP 21-01 will be materially detrimental to the public welfare or injurious to the property or improvements in the vicinity of the proposed use, please also consider these important points:

- As incidents at the Long Beach facility clearly demonstrate, patients can leave at any time, for any reason, with or without notice, with or without their belongings, and even when it is against medical advice.
- As the incidents at the Long Beach facility show, patients leave or flee the facility on foot (which
 makes sense because Applicants' application says patients are prohibited from bringing their
 own vehicles).
- Again as the incidents show, once a patient has left or fled the property on foot, Discover
 Recovery has no obligation or duty to find these patients, or to give notice to the police,
 surrounding residences, schools, churches or other nearby uses that the patient has left or fled
 the facility.
- In fact, as one Discover Recovery nurse stated to the Pacific County Sheriff dispatch, "We don't typically call when patients leave against medical advice."
- The reports indicate that the leaving or fleeing patients often suffer from mental health issues, personality disorders, suicidal ideations, or even in one instance "meth psychosis." And, shockingly, as the reports indicate, <u>Discover Recovery has no idea where the patients go when they re-enter the community</u>.

Listed below are summaries of Pacific County Sheriff Reports describing calls to the Sheriff dispatch related to patients leaving or fleeing the Long Beach facility (or, in one instance a patient experiencing a psychotic break outside the facility). Actual sheriff reports and two audio transcripts are provided as an attachment to these comments. These are only a handful of incidents that the Dorothy Fox Safety Alliance could locate records for. Assuredly, there are many more incidents because, as a nurse there stated, they don't normally report patients who leave against medical advice.

Any one of these Long Beach reports, on its face, creates a public welfare concern, along with a concern for the patient. However, please consider the how the public welfare would be materially and detrimentally impacted if any one of these incidents happened next to an elementary school during school hours, or a park with public bathrooms and a playground, or a church with a pre-school, or while kids are walking to and from their school each day.

The freedom for patients to leave at any time and for any reason, coupled with Discover Recovery's lack of duty or obligation to locate these patients or give notice to local public safety authorities or Dorothy Fox, Harvest Church or the surrounding residences is materially detrimental to the public welfare in, on and around the proposed location. Again, substance abuse treatment services are needed and play an important role in our society, however providing such service at this specific location is unreasonable, irresponsible and wholly incompatible with the sensitive uses surrounding the property.

February 23, 2021 (See also Audio Transcript of this call)

Pacific County Sheriff Report - Patient Left Facility Unattended/Unaccompanied Against Medical Advice

Comments: <u>Happened just last month</u>. Interesting to note that Discover Recovery feels that a patient in "some sort of meth psychosis" running away from the facility is "not an emergency." Also, the facility acknowledges that the patient is likely out in the community, in the rain, with nowhere to go.

Report Summary:

- Discovery Recovery tells dispatch this is "not an emergency", just "keep an eye out for" this
 patient.
- Patient was admitted that day and "looked like he was in like some sort of meth psychosis."
- "And he just took off running."
- "Umm...if you guys come across him in the evening...somehow...which it is a small city, I'm sure you guys will...he's more than welcome to come back to the facility."
- "Umm, but I think he would come back and feel good about it. Uh...especially when he realizes it's raining and nasty out and there's nowhere to go."

Comments: Called police 20-30 minutes after patient left against medical advice. Normally do not call in these types of situations. Discover Recovery had no idea where the patient was.

Dear Members of the Camas City Government,

I'm writing to share my concerns about the placement of a Discover Recovery Center next to Dorothy Fox Elementary School.

As you well know, school properties are usually areas that are protected by the communities they serve. Since they serve such an important function in the community, and because children are such a vulnerable population, most cities make sure that the areas around schools are kept safe, quiet, and conducive to learning. Especially in this era of lockdown drills and school shooting preparations, safety and calm at school is top of mind for every parent as we drop our children off at school each morning.

I want to make it clear that I am not at all against having a drug recover center in Camas. Like schools, such centers serve a very important function in the communities that they serve. I feel strongly that drug addiction is a health-care issue, and that people who are suffering from addiction deserve the same level of compassionate care and help that we would provide for someone suffering from any other medical ailment. With the abundant natural beauty in this area, Camas could be an ideal place for people to turn their lives around and regain their health.

With that being said, I'm just not convinced that putting a for-profit recovery center run by out of town owners directly next to an elementary school is the most appropriate way to serve both of these needs in Camas. We would never consider putting a hospital next to an elementary school, because we know that the noise of sirens and the types of 24/7 activity at a hospital would not make the best neighbor for a school. That doesn't mean we don't want any hospitals in our community. Of course we do-we need them, and they are vital members of our community. It just means that placing them directly next to a school isn't the best option for anyone involved. Children need to be free to walk back and forth to school, run outside on the playground and attend class daily without being worried about what's happening directly over the fence. Likewise, those seeking drug recovery treatment deserve to do so in a peaceful space that gives them the freedom to work on their health without the constant community scrutiny that will inevitably come from sandwiching the treatment center next to a school full of young children. Putting these two very different, yet very important community resources right next to each other seems to be needlessly inviting problems. Wouldn't it better serve both the elementary school and drug treatment communities to find a more logical and thoughtful place in Camas to set up the treatment center? I believe so.

Thank you very much for your time and consideration of this issue.






