

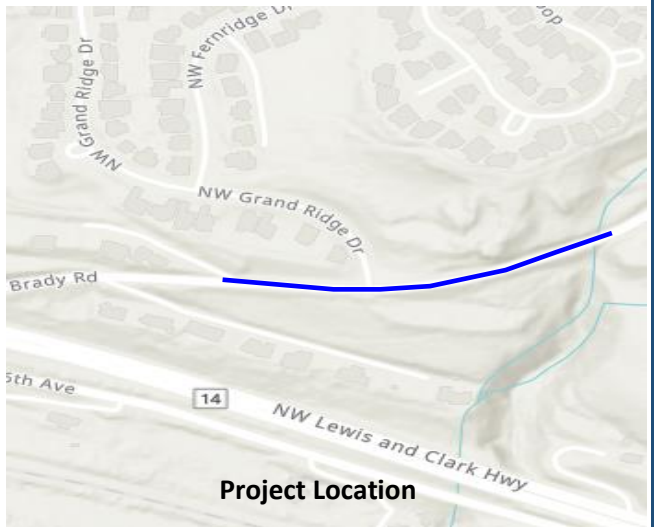


NW Brady Road and Grand Ridge Drive Intersection Improvements

Project Type: Intersection Safety and Street Preservation

Total Project Cost: \$254,000

Project Timeline: June 2021 – July 2023



Project Description

In 2016 the City took ownership of NW Brady Road from NW McIntosh Road Southeast to City Vancouver limits from Clark County (Grand Ridge Annexation). After taking ownership, many citizens reached out to staff and council with concerns regarding intersection safety. This projects scope was to improve intersection safety by addressing the most frequent crash types through installation of safety countermeasures while rehabilitating the aging roadway surface.

Project Details and Benefits

- Improved Intersection safety by adding intersection illumination, left turn pocket, profiled pavement markings, reduced lane widths, and improved sight distance.
- Restored 1,000 Lineal Feet of asphalt surfacing.
- This Project was noted on the Six Year Transportation Improvement Plan beginning in 2020.
