

RESOLUTION NO. 26-009

A RESOLUTION authorizing the Mayor to sign the State of Washington's Recreation & Conservation Office's Grant Application Authorization form.

WHEREAS, the City of Camas Parks & Recreation Department strives to provide enhanced recreational opportunities for all its residents; and

WHEREAS, the 2022 Parks, Recreation and Open Space Plan identifies Maintaining What We Have as a key priority; and

WHEREAS, the Camas Strategic Plan identifies Vibrant Community Amenities and Stewardship of City Assets as priorities; and

WHEREAS, Forest Home Park is home to Camas Little League, hosting approximately 600 baseball and softball games per year, and is the heaviest used baseball field in the Camas parks system, and

WHEREAS, the Forest Home Park field needs improvements, including artificial turf, flexible pitching mound and base paths, outfield drainage repairs, LED lighting, and ADA compliant amenities, to better serve athletes, coaches and spectators of all ages and abilities; and

WHEREAS, the City is applying for funding assistance for the field improvements through the State of Washington's Recreation & Conservation Office's Youth Athletic Facilities grant program; and

WHEREAS, the Youth Athletic Facilities grant application requires a City Council resolution to authorize the Mayor, or other designated City representative, to sign an authorization form acknowledging the application for said grant.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CAMAS AS FOLLOWS:

Section I

That the Mayor of the City of Camas be authorized to sign the State of Washington's Recreation & Conservation Office's Grant Application Authorization form in support of the Parks and Recreation Department's application for Forest Home Park Field Improvements through the Youth Athletic Facilities grant program.
