Thank you for your continuing assistance with the development of Oak Tree Station, a unique combination of dining options which will bring a delightful smorgasbord of cuisine to north Camas. Enclosed with this letter are professional consulting reports on traffic, wetlands and archeology.

The traffic report describes the trip generation and will serve as the basis for discussion on the Traffic Impact Fee. The critical areas report addresses those issues and is consistent with the site plan.

The archeology survey was completed in 2008 for a prior proposed development that did not come to fruition. That report included shovel probes at numerous points around the site, which revealed no evidence of archeological or cultural resources. In sum, it is a clean report that was accepted by DAHP; indeed, we obtained our copy from their office. Additional reports from the area were received from DAHP and are included as well.
