## Fines and Penalties - Municipal Code Violations

Administrative penalties for most violations of the Municipal Code fall under one of four tiers:

- Tier one violations fifty dollars (\$50);
- Tier two violations one hundred dollars (\$100);
- Tier three violations two hundred fifty dollars (\$250);
- Tier four violations five hundred dollars (\$500);

A list of Municipal Code violations and their assigned tier can be found on the following pages.

Additional Municipal Code violations and assigned penalties that are not part of the tiered structure can be found on the pages following the tier four violations list.

Administrative penalties for violation of the City of Capitola Municipal Code shall be set forth as the below schedule except:

The administrative penalties for all violations of the Municipal Code not specifically set forth in the below schedule shall be as follows in accordance with Municipal Code Section 4.04.010:

- one hundred dollars (\$100) for first violation;
- two hundred dollars (\$200) for second violation within a period of one year;
- five hundred dollars (\$500) for each additional violation of the same ordinance within a period of one year.

The administrative penalty for all violations classified as misdemeanors in the Municipal Code shall be as follows in accordance with Municipal Code Section 1.01.090:

• five hundred dollars (\$500) for each misdemeanor
