The BIA would like to replace the current rope lights on the palm trees in the village.

- The lights would be warm tone rather than the current white tone
- The lights are part of the holiday theme of "The Village of Lights"
- There are 27 palm trees in the village with lights to be replaced
- The lights would be replaced with the same type of rope light, in warm tone, which has proven to be durable and is reasonably priced keeping within the BIA budget for village enhancement
- An added step would improve dependability by better protecting the connection between the lights and the power source with a sleeve
- The BIA has liability insurance


We would like to see the lights replaced before Thanksgiving. Installation options are the city crew or professional installer. We are currently soliciting quotes for the professional installation. There are no plans to replace the lights on the large palm tree as they are newer and working well.
