Background

- Annual Fee Schedule Update:
 - Reflect current service costs
 - Maintain cost recovery goals
- Comprehensive Fee Study
 - Conducted by Willdan Financial Services

Purpose of the Fee Study

- Determine actual cost of City services
- Recommend cost recovery rates
- Account for:
 - Inflation
 - Salary increases
 - Service delivery changes
 - Add/remove fees for new/discontinued services
- Address fees below full cost recovery to reduce General Fund dependency

Legal Considerations

- State Law Compliance:
 - Fees cannot exceed the cost of providing services
 - California Propositions 218 and 26 restrict fee amounts

Recommended Adjustments

- Public Works Department
 - Increased fees for traffic control plan reviews, construction parking permits, and stormwater development reviews
 - Introduction of new inspection and permit fees
- Police Department
 - Increase for special event permits, sound permits, etc.
 - New fees introduced for vehicle boot removal, tow hearings, and other services

Recommended Adjustments

- Planning Division
 - Several fees decreasing
 - New fees for complex applications and environmental reviews
 - Childcare Facilities: Fees set to zero per Council request
- Building Division
 - Building plan checks and inspection fees adjusted for larger projects
 - New fees for permit extensions and reinstatements
 - New fees for Electric Vehicle Charging Permits & Solar P.V.
 Systems
 - No fee for solar hot water heater

Recommended Adjustments

- Community Services and Recreation Department
 - 2% increase for facility rentals
 - No increase in youth program registration fees
 - New fee for registration/reservation cancellation or change
- Other Adjustments
 - Historical Museum: No changes
 - Outdoor Dining Space Rent: Increased by 3.67% CPI adjustment (from \$1.50 to \$1.56 per sq. ft.)
