Re: Item 8F - Adoption of FY 2025–26 Road Project List

Staff wishes to note a correction to Item 8F (Adoption of FY 2025–26 Road Project List). The staff report correctly states that the City is projected to receive \$258,668 in SB 1 funding. However, the originally published resolution included an incorrect funding amount.

The resolution has been revised to reflect the correct SB 1 amount of \$258,668. No other changes have been made.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CAPITOLA ADOPTING A LIST OF PROJECTS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2025-2026 FUNDED BY SENATE BILL 1: THE ROAD REPAIR AND ACCOUNTABILITY ACT OF 2017

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 1 (SB 1), the Road Repair and Accountability Act of 2017 (Chapter 5, Statutes of 2017) was passed by the Legislature and Signed into law by the Governor in April 2017 to address the significant multi-modal transportation funding shortfalls statewide; and

WHEREAS, SB 1 includes accountability and transparency provisions that will ensure the residents of our City are aware of the projects proposed for funding in our community and which projects have been completed each fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, the City must adopt by resolution a list of projects proposed to receive fiscal year funding from the Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account (RMRA), created by SB 1, which must include a description and the location of each proposed project, a proposed schedule for the project's completion, and the estimated useful life of the improvement; and

WHEREAS, the City, will receive an estimated \$258,668 in RMRA funding in Fiscal Year 2025-2026 from SB 1; and

WHEREAS, this is the ninth year in which the City is receiving SB 1 funding and will enable the City to continue essential road maintenance and rehabilitation projects, safety improvements, repairing and replacing aging bridges, and increasing access and mobility options for the traveling public that would not have otherwise been possible without SB 1; and

WHEREAS, the City has undergone a robust public process to ensure public input into our community's transportation priorities/the project list; and

WHEREAS, the City completed an update to the pavement management program in 2022 to develop a five year SB 1 project list to ensure revenues are being used on the most high-priority and cost-effective projects that also meet the City's priorities for transportation investment; and

WHEREAS, the funding from SB 1 will help the City complete needed pavement management improvement projects; and

WHEREAS, the SB 1 project list and overall investment in our local streets and roads infrastructure with a focus on basic maintenance and safety, investing in complete streets infrastructure, and using cutting-edge technology, materials and practices, will provide dedicated source of funding for roadway projects.

NOW, THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, ORDERED AND FOUND by the City Council of the City of Capitola, State of California, as follows:

- 2. The following list of proposed projects will be funded in-part or solely with Fiscal Year 2025-2026 Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account revenues:
