Subject: Disposition of Unclaimed Checks



<u>Recommended Action</u>: Authorize the release of unclaimed checks in accordance with Government Code Section 50055.

<u>Background</u>: California Government Code Section 50055 allows unclaimed checks of three years to become the property of the local agency after public noticing, and unclaimed checks of less than \$15 to become the property of the local agency after a period of one year without the necessity of publication of a notice in the newspaper. The latter action must be authorized by the local agency's legislative body.

<u>Discussion</u>: In the City's financial system, there are four (4) checks that meet the criteria above. A public notice has been placed in the Santa Cruz Sentinel for the two (2) checks for more than \$15.00. The two (2) remaining checks are \$15.00 or less and require City Council approval to void and return the funds to the General Fund. These checks are enumerated below:
