Subject: CalRecycle Grant Programs



<u>Recommended Action</u>: Adopt a resolution authorizing the application for grant funds from the California Department of Resources, Recycling, and Recovery (CalRecycle).

<u>Background</u>: The California Department of Resources, Recycling, and Recovery (CalRecycle) administers various statewide recycling and waste management programs aimed at promoting increased recycling and reducing litter in the waste stream.

Over the last 18 years, the City of Capitola has received over \$150,000 in grant funds from CalRecycle. These grant funds have been applied to Citywide waste reduction programs, such as used oil recycling, beverage container recycling, and food waste recovery. For the City to continue receiving CalRecycle grant funding, staff requests the City Council adopt a resolution (Attachment 1) authorizing the City Manager to execute all required application documents, receive any grant awards, and execute any grant renewals through 2028.

<u>Fiscal Impact</u>: There is no immediate financial impact or budget action necessary because of the recommended action. Staff will return to the City Council if grants are awarded and specific budget actions are required in the future.
