Subject: Community Grant 2022-25 Fund Allocation - Community Action

Board

<u>Recommended Action</u>: Consider the recommendation of the Community Grant Subcommittee to award the Community Action Board of Santa Cruz County \$10,000 as part of the Community Grant Program.

<u>Background</u>: The City of Capitola Community Grant Program funds non-profit organizations that provide services to City residents. Grant applications for Year 2022-2023 were due on August 15 and on August 25, City Council appointed Vice-Mayor Keiser and Council Member Brown to review Community Grant Program FY 2022-25 applications.

On September 8, staff met with the subcommittee and received a recommendation on how to allocate available grant funding to applicants.

The City received 24 applications from 23 different organizations.

<u>Discussion</u>: The Community Grant subcommittee reviewed the application from Community Action Board of Santa Cruz County (CAB). CAB requested a \$15,000 Stable/Affordable Housing/Shelter Outcome Grant.

Council is considering this application separately from the overall Community Grant Program due to conflicts of interest in this item.

<u>Fiscal Impact</u>: The Fiscal Year 2022-23 General Fund impact for the recommended award to Community Action Board is \$10,000.
