I recommend steering the bicycle riders OFF Bay ave and sending them down to the Mid County senior Center, through the fence to the PAMF building, along the river to PEERY park. The riders can choose whether to ride to the village on Riverview ave OR cross the bridge to Wharf road.

Also, Traversing the congested area in front of Nob Hill is equally tough. Getting the bikes off that route would be safer.

I suppose the village would have a "New Sign" saying "RiverView Bike Route". with an arrow pointed to Riverview Ave.
