Reserved Parking Information:
The turnaround area directly in front of the entrance to Capitola wharf is reserved for emergency
vehicles ambulance/fire truck and the Pyrotechic crew trucks as well as first alarm guard.
•
Street Closure Information:
The entrance to the Capitola Wharf will be closed to the public so that the pyrotechnics will not be meddled with at any time during the set up and lasting until cleanup is complete after the fireworks have been fired for the show. Requesting 1400 Wharf Road closure so the Fire engines have emergency access if need be and an ambulace usually is stationed there as well. The entrance to the Wharf is reserved so that the Pyrotechnic crew can work there and so that the First Alarm guard can park at the wharf entrance to enforce the wharf closure.
Police Needs:

Lifeguard/First Aid Needs:
Toilet Facilities Plan:
We provide the Zambelli pyrotechnic crew, First Alarm guard and officers of the Monte Foundation porta potties on site at the Capitola Wharf.
Garbage/Recycling Plan:
We work with Save Our Shores nonprofit to conduct beach cleanup on the two mornings after the firework show is held ensuring any pyrotechnic debris is cleared off the shore and beach as well as any other trash found on the beach.
Other Pertinent Information Not Listed on Application:
One guard from First Alarm is employed to enforce the closure of the wharf and watch/guard the entrance so no one without clearance for conducting the pyrotechnic show has access. Concerning cleanup timeline on the 14th the morning after: Daybreak: the Zambelli crew makes the final sweep of the wharf and surrounding beach/area for any debris or unexploded devices.  8 AM: Final debriefing and Zambelli crew departs.
