Subject: Stockton Avenue Bridge Repairs Design Contract



Recommended Action: Authorize the City Manager to execute a Professional Services Agreement with Moffatt and Nichol in an amount not to exceed \$34,488 for design, permitting, and construction support services for the repair of for the Stockton Avenue Bridge in substantially similar form, as approved by the City Attorney, as the attached agreement.

<u>Background</u>: On January 5, 2023, Stockton Avenue Bridge sustained damage to the pier walls and west wing wall due to storm activity. The damage does not currently threaten the integrity of the bridge but requires immediate repair. Staff has been advised by Caltrans staff to pursue repairs though the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) Emergency Relief Program.

<u>Discussion</u>: Staff solicited a proposal for design, permitting, and construction support services to two firms and received the attached proposal from Moffat and Nichol (Appendix 1 to Attachment 1).

Upon the award of contract, Moffatt and Nichol will immediately begin to complete an engineered design to bid for emergency repairs. Estimated start of construction is early June 2023.

<u>Fiscal Impact</u>: Both design and repair costs are anticipated to be 100% reimbursable under the FHWA Emergency Relief Program.
