RESOLUTION NO. 26-2356

RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE CAPE FEAR PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY APPLICATION TO THE FEDERAL TRANSIT ADMINISTRATION PILOT PROGRAM FOR TRANSIT-ORIENTED DEVELOPMENT PLANNING

WHEREAS, the Cape Fear Public Transportation Authority, doing business as Wave Transit, intends to submit an application to the Federal Transit Administration Pilot Program for Transit-Oriented Development Planning – Section 20005(b); and

WHEREAS, the planning grant would provide funding for a study to identify opportunities for high-capacity transit investment within the Wilmington urbanized area, including improved regional connections serving the Town of Carolina Beach; and

WHEREAS, work to be performed under the study would include examining innovative ways of connecting Downtown Wilmington to major health centers, including Novant Health Regional Medical Center, Wilmington Health, the planned UNC Health medical campus at Shipyard Boulevard and Independence Boulevard, and other key destinations such as Monkey Junction and the Town of Carolina Beach; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Council of the Town of Carolina Beach, North Carolina, that the Town Council hereby supports the application of the Cape Fear Public Transportation Authority, dba Wave Transit, to the Federal Transit Administration Pilot Program for Transit-Oriented Development Planning – Section 20005(b).
