WHEREAS in 1872, the Nebraska Board of Agriculture established a special day

WHEREAS this holiday, called Arbor Day, was first observed with the planting

of more than a million trees in Nebraska, and

WHEREAS Arbor Day is now observed throughout the nation and the world,

and

WHEREAS trees can be a solution to combating climate change by reducing

the erosion of our precious topsoil by wind and water, cutting heating and cooling costs, moderating the temperature, cleaning the air, producing life-saving oxygen, and providing habitat for

wildlife, and

WHEREAS trees in our city increase property values, enhance the economic

vitality of business areas, and beautify our community, and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Albert L. Barbee, Mayor of the Town of Carolina Beach, do hereby

proclaim April 29, 2023 as National Arbor Day, and I urge all citizens to celebrate Arbor Day and support efforts to protect our trees and

woodlands, and

FURTHER, I urge all citizens to plant trees to promote the well-being of this

and future generations.
