PLAN CONSISTENCY STATEMENT AND RECOMMENDATION OF THE TOWN OF CAROLINA BEACH PLANNING AND ZONING COMMISSION

Having reviewed the proposed update and rewrite of the Town of Carolina Beach Land Development Code, having considered information from Town staff, and having considered comments from the public pursuant to Section 160D-604 of the North Carolina General, the Planning and Zoning Commission hereby adopts one of the following statements:

	land use Chapters 30, 32, 36, and 40 and the adoption of the Town's first Unified Development
	Ordinance (UDO) to the Town Council and finds that (i) it is not consistent with the Town's
	comprehensive plan (2020 CAMA Land Use Plan) and all other applicable plans and policies
	adopted by the Town and/or (ii) it is not in the public interest for the following
	reasons:
