

My short answer /position is that open space and water quality need about 90 days to review all the details and provide a reasonable input.

I believe when P&K made their presentation they made a statement that all storm water went into the pit. This may be true but it brings more questions on the depth of the pit. Level of ground water under the pit. Water quality testing for their wells and well of houses in the area. Also I found out from DEP gravel and quarry lead that P&K requested and received a variance to discharge storm water outside the pit. Maybe I missed that but don't think so.

Also one of the holding pools is within 200 feet of wetlands.

There is a lot to look at and their contract zone does not expire until 2028. We should not rush this.
