

## RESOLUTION 2026-001

### A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF CENTURY, ESCAMBIA COUNTY, FLORIDA ADOPTING THE 2025 LOCAL MITIGATION STRATEGY PLAN:

**WHEREAS**, The Town of Century, Escambia County, Florida is subject to various natural or anthropogenic hazards such as tropical storms, wildfire, flooding, and chemical spills; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Century recognizes that disasters do not recognize city, county, or special district boundaries; and

**WHEREAS**, the federal Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 requires all cities, counties, and special districts to have adopted a Local Hazard Mitigation Plan to receive disaster mitigation funding from FEMA; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town Council seeks to maintain and enhance both a disaster-resistant Town of Century, Escambia County and region by reducing the potential loss of life, property damage, and environmental degradation from natural disasters, while accelerating economic recovery from those disasters; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Century is committed to increasing the disaster resistance of the infrastructure, health, housing, economy, government services, education, environment, and land use systems in the County; and

### NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CENTURY, ESCAMBIA COUNTY, FLORIDA AS FOLLOWS:

**Section 1.** That the Town of Century hereby adopts the Escambia County LMS Group Multi-Jurisdictional Plan to identify and implement hazard mitigation initiatives to reduce the county's susceptibility to numerous hazards.

**Section 2.** That this resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption by the Town Council.
