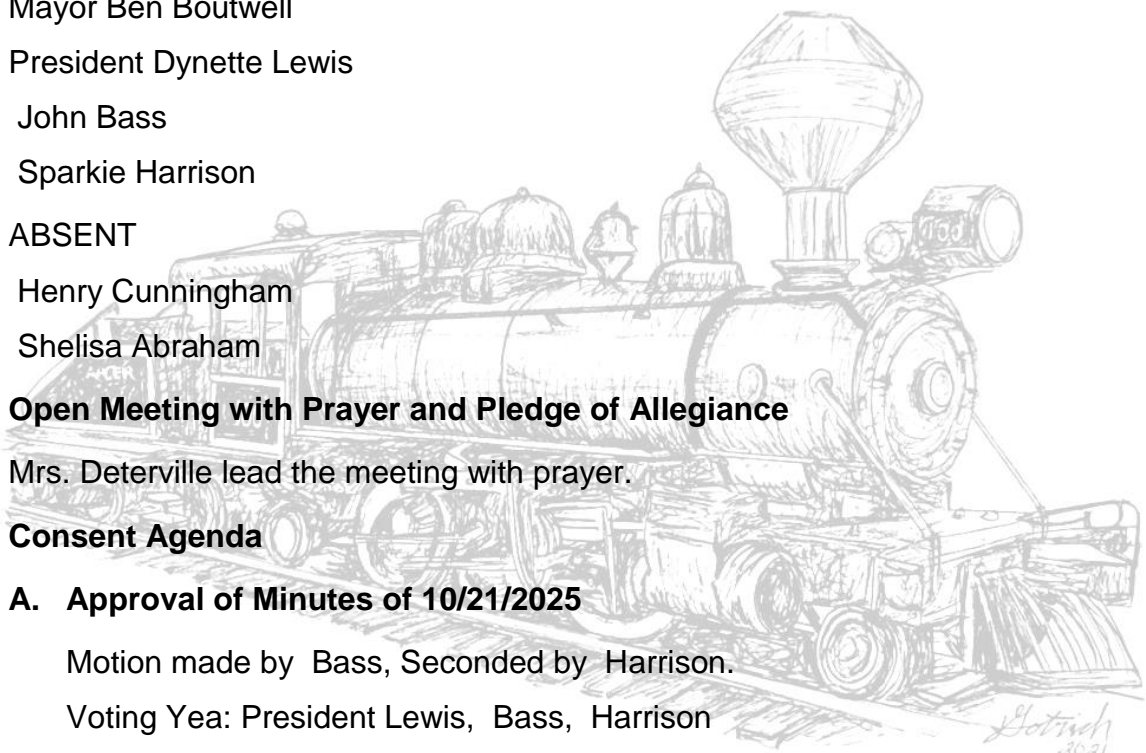
Councilmember Bass would like to know what to know what it is being used for.
