RESOLUTION NO. 2025-10

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CENTURY, FLORIDA, APPROVING CHANGE ORDER NO. 2 FOR THE CENTURY MISCELLANEOUS WASTEWATER IMPROVEMENTS (PHASE II) PROJECT; PROVIDING FOR PAYMENT OF ADDITIONAL COSTS FROM TOWN FUNDS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Town of Century is currently undertaking the Century Miscellaneous Wastewater Improvements (Phase II) Project; and

WHEREAS, the Contractor, Talcon Group, LLC, has submitted Change Order No. 2 in the amount of \$62,700.00 with a contract time extension of sixty (60) days for the demolition and reconstruction of the existing sludge press building; and

WHEREAS, significant structural deterioration of the sludge press building framing, columns, purlins, and girts has been documented, making replacement more cost-effective and structurally sound than repair; and

WHEREAS, Municipal Engineering Services, Inc., after inspection and review, has recommended approval of the Change Order as being in order and reasonable under the circumstances; and

WHEREAS, this Change Order will exceed the project's existing grant funding, requiring the additional cost to be paid from Town funds (LOST or another designated account);

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CENTURY, FLORIDA:

1. Approval of Change Order No. 2. The Town Council hereby approves Change Order No. 2 with Talcon Group, LLC, in the amount of \$62,700.00 and sixty (60) additional calendar days, for the demolition and reconstruction of the sludge press building.

- 2. Funding Source. The additional cost of \$62,700.00 shall be paid from Town funds, specifically LOST funds or such other account as may be designated by the Town Council.
- 3. Execution. The Mayor is authorized to execute Change Order No. 2 and any necessary documents on behalf of the Town of Century.
- 4. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
