Water Department

5th Street – all service lines have been installed between Endly Street up to Jefferson Street.

Slip Line work is currently underway along the Septic right of way. Right of Way clearing is still in progress as well.

Street Department

5th Street – Maintaining roadway and fixing potholes as needed until the final paving is completed.
