During the last few weeks the guys at the Town Shop have stepped up again. With water line installs & repairs, to removal of storm debris and brush. Work on the Well's Fargo Bank is still ongoing and getting closer to completion.

Street Department

The Street Crew guys have been doing a great job with the brush, limbs and other debris. Add in the storm debris, they have had a lot to contend with. They have been keeping the Cemetery, Airport and Pavilion looking nice for the events held at each respective sight. They have had a time in doing so, but the grass cutting is under better control. This past week, the guys from both crews, have gotten a lot of the holes from line repairs filled in with asphalt. We still have a few more areas to be filled soon.

Maintenance

The shop guys have also been doing a good job on the vehicles and the machinery. We got the Dumpster Truck back and returned it to service. Some minor cosmetic repair. They have been working on putting the Side Arm Tractor back together after servicing some of the parts. A couple of the Police vehicles have been cleaned out and stripped down for the upcoming sale.

Chris put in a set of new breakers at the Pavilion. He also started installing new, bigger fans for the bathrooms. Meanwhile, he's started painting the offices at Well's Fargo.

Water Department

The Water Crew was busy with 3 water line leaks and repairs. They were able to handle them with no problems. A new water/sewer tap had to be made up in the Thynedale area for a new home being put up. They also managed to get all of the sewer right-a-ways cut and cleaned. The slip lining project was also finished up, hopefully this will help the I&I at the WWTP. The crew also helped with putting the asphalt down. They have also had a few graves to deal with as well.
