Dance Pad at the Pavilion has been completed!!! Topsoil, grass seed and straw have been put down around the edges. We are looking into Large planters to place around the sides to hold poles for Lighting.

Street Department

Obtaining quotes for replacement dumpsters. 5 need to be replaced. Currently, we have no spare dumpsters available. Several Dumpsters have been patched and repaired already. Street Crew has been steadily keeping up with all of the grass cutting and yard debris removal. They have also repaired and replaced several street signs in various locations.

Maintenance

Painting and building repairs at the Airport are complete. Repairs have been made to the fence around the playground as well as repairs to a vandalized panel on one of the pieces of equipment.

Water Department

Crew and Contractor is finishing up the sewer cleaning and camera work on the lines. After all of that is final, they will look at the videos and determine the repair points for the Sliplining. Crew also replaced the fire hydrant at the Fire Department training grounds.
