

Public Works Monthly Update -July 2022

Robert E. Lee building had a substantial water leak in the Men's bathroom on July 11th. Water and Power were turned off to the building. Water still is turned off due to deteriorated pipes. Power has been restored. The water saturation to the wood floor has buckled and damaged several areas. The building has been opened daily and fans have been used to dry the areas as much as possible.

The new Leaf-Vac has been delivered. It has also been put to use already along Main Street.

Street Department

Pot hole repairs have been completed on several streets around town. 5th street has been temporarily patched until the contractor can do final repairs and paving in September.

Maintenance

Primary Trash Truck is out of service for repairs. Back-up truck is being used. Parts for repairs have been delivered. Repairs should be done within two weeks. Parts have also been ordered for needed repairs on the Back-Hoe.

Replaced fan and radiator on Town Police vehicle (Dodge Charge) Inspections done on White Tahoe (Police). Other repairs have been made on several other town vehicles.

Water Department

A 4 inch Water line extension is being installed on Roark Street from the intersection with Roberts towards Newby (approximately 400').

Old Landfill was inspected. Property has been bush hogged. New locks have been placed on the Inspection pipes and well heads to stay in compliance.

All of the camera work and cleaning of the Sewer System has been completed. Awaiting word from Tri-State on when they will start the Slip-Lining.

Other Updates

Cleaning of the Wells Fargo building is in progress.

Some Flag Poles along Main Street have been replaced with sturdier metal poles.
