1. **Section A, Agreement Period**, is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

The Agreement is effective as of July 1, 2022 (the "Effective Date") and shall continue until the earlier to occur of (a) June 30, 2025 ("the Expiration Date") or (b) the date on which either Party terminates this Agreement (the "Termination Date"). The period of time between the Effective Date and the Expiration Date or Termination Date is the "Agreement Period".

- 2. The Agreement is hereby reinstated as though it has not expired.
- 3. All other terms and conditions of the Agreement not otherwise amended remain in full force and effect.
