Utility Kiosk

Project: We have reached out to companies about kiosks and we are currently working with our software provider to determine the best route for us to go in order to be able to make the most efficient use of the equipment we purchase. Some kiosks are compatible and some are not so we are working through that and will know more in the next 30 days. At that point a software interface will have to be completed.

Employee Performance Management System

Project: We currently have the new system in place and we are working toward finalizing the evaluation documents and settings in the system to be able to make the most efficient use of the program we purchased called NewGov Perform. We are currently on track to have it completed in order for evaluations to be done for all employees during the month of June.

GPS System for City Vehicles

Project: The Council approved an agreement last month with Verizon for a GPS tracking system for city vehicles. The first ten units have been installed and as soon as we receive the balance of the units they will be installed on the 43 remaining vehicles.
