



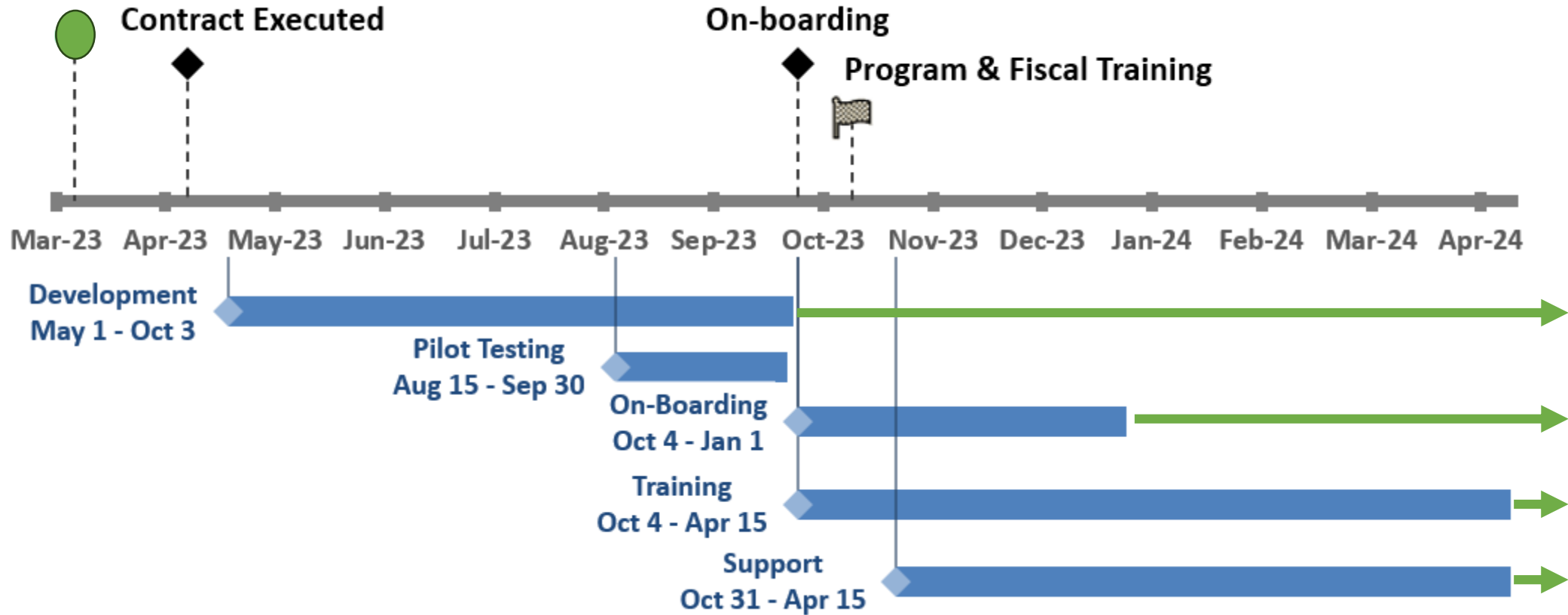

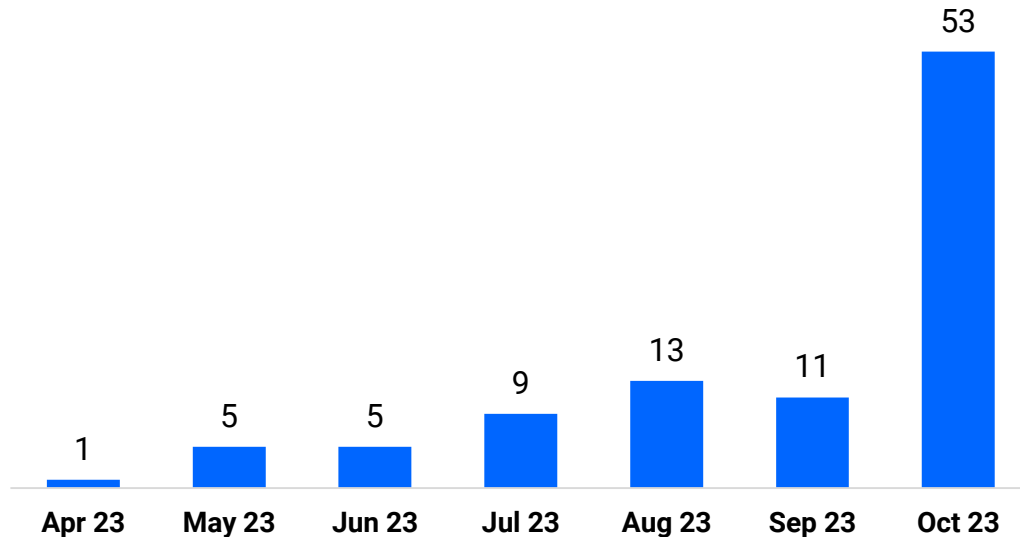

Unique User Logins

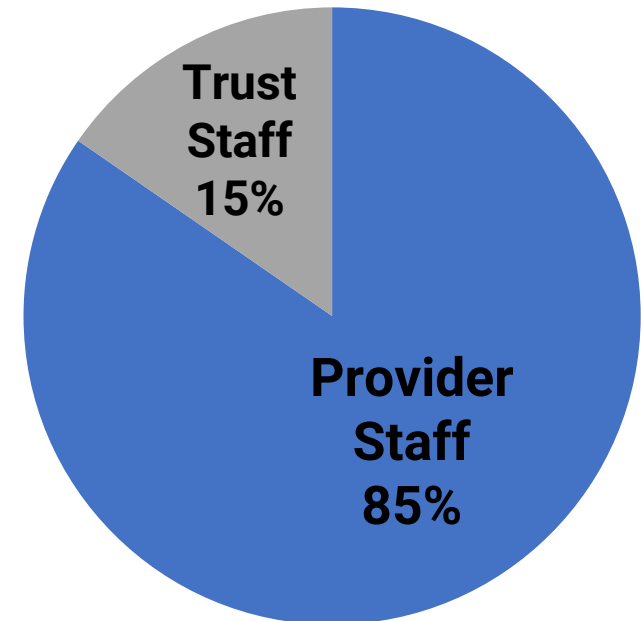
