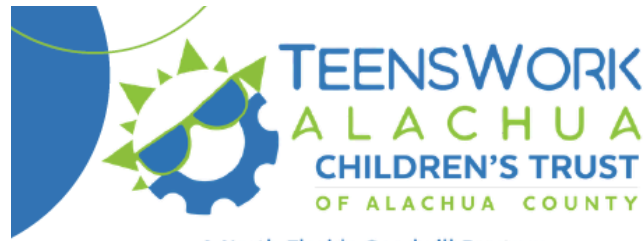

SUCCESS STORIES

University of Florida Saving Smiles | Success Story - July

This month, The Saving Smiles team celebrated a remarkable transformation in the oral health and confidence of a 16-year-old patient who first presented to our program in March 2026 with extensive dental disease. At her initial visit, she had cavities affecting nearly all of her permanent teeth, including her front teeth. Several permanent molars were severely decayed and deemed non-restorable, with only root fragments remaining. In addition, her upper front teeth had large cavities that had extended into the dental pulp, causing pain and requiring root canal treatment. Following her evaluation, our team developed a comprehensive treatment plan and referred her to the University of Florida College of Dentistry for specialty endodontic care. Through Saving Smiles, she continued receiving preventive dental services, oral health education, fillings, and removal of non-restorable teeth while coordinating her specialty treatment.

When she returned to our program this month, the results were truly inspiring. She had successfully completed all needed root canal treatments, and her front teeth had been restored with beautiful, functional restorations. Most importantly, she was free from dental pain and smiled confidently throughout her appointment. The improvement in both her oral health and self-esteem was evident. A key factor in this patient's success was the ongoing support of our community health worker, who played an essential role in coordinating appointments, helping the family navigate specialty care, and ensuring the patient remained engaged in treatment. This collaborative approach helped the patient complete complex specialty care while maintaining regular preventive and general dental visits through our program. Her story demonstrates how comprehensive care coordination, community-based support, and access to specialty dental services can dramatically improve both health outcomes and quality of life for underserved youth.

University of Florida Saving Smiles | Success Story - June

Saving Smiles This month we were able to help a 7-year-old boy who was experiencing significant pain in his lower left tooth. Upon examination and X-rays, he was found to have a baby molar with a very large cavity requiring urgent treatment. His mother shared that he had previously been taken to the emergency room due to the severity of his toothache and was referred to a pediatric dentist but was unable to secure an appointment for several months due to long wait times. During his visit with our team, we were able to provide same-day treatment by removing the affected tooth. This intervention relieved his pain and helped prevent further infection. The child tolerated the procedure well and was able to leave the clinic comfortable and smiling. He is now scheduled to return to our next clinic for preventive care to help protect his remaining teeth and support his long-term oral health.

Child Advocacy Center - Reducing Trauma Therapy Program | Success Story - June

A 15-year-old female entered trauma-focused treatment after experiencing years of sexual abuse by her father, as well as physical abuse, substance exposure, and ongoing emotional maltreatment throughout her development. At the time of disclosure, she experienced limited support from her mother, contributing to feelings of isolation and mistrust. Upon beginning services, she exhibited significant trauma-related symptoms, including running away, chronic school avoidance, intrusive flashbacks, an exaggerated startle response, and self-harming behaviors.

Throughout treatment, the client has demonstrated significant progress in her recovery. She has experienced a substantial reduction in trauma symptoms, including fewer trauma reminders, improved emotional regulation, and increased feelings of safety. She is no longer engaging in self-harm behaviors and has developed healthier coping strategies to manage distress. The client has also identified and strengthened a positive support network through trusted adults at school and has become actively involved in a team sport, providing opportunities to build healthy peer relationships, increase self-confidence, and foster resilience. In addition, her mother has become increasingly receptive to psychoeducation regarding the impact of trauma and is demonstrating greater willingness to learn strategies to support her daughter's healing. As treatment continues, the client has shown improved engagement in school and extracurricular activities, strengthened protective factors, and increased confidence in her ability to maintain her progress and continue her path toward healing.

PEAK Literacy| Success Story - June

For the month of June, PEAK Literacy is proud to celebrate the graduation of a student who joined PEAK Literacy in fifth grade reading at a 2.3 grade level; nearly three full years behind where they needed to be. With consistent support, personalized instruction, and the dedication of their volunteer tutor, this student made extraordinary progress over the course of nine months with our program.

By the time they graduated this month, the student had reached a 5.3 grade level; a three full grade level gain that brought them right to grade level proficiency. That kind of growth in under a year is a testament to what high-dosage, individualized tutoring can accomplish when a student is committed and supported.

Perhaps equally meaningful was the shift in confidence. When the student first joined, their parent described their confidence in reading as fair — a word that spoke to hesitation and self-doubt. By the end of the program, that same parent described their child's confidence as good, reflecting a student who now approaches reading with assurance and belief in their own abilities.

This student's journey reminds us that academic growth and personal growth go hand in hand. We are proud of everything they have accomplished and look forward to seeing them thrive as a confident, capable reader.
