 4. Human Trafficking

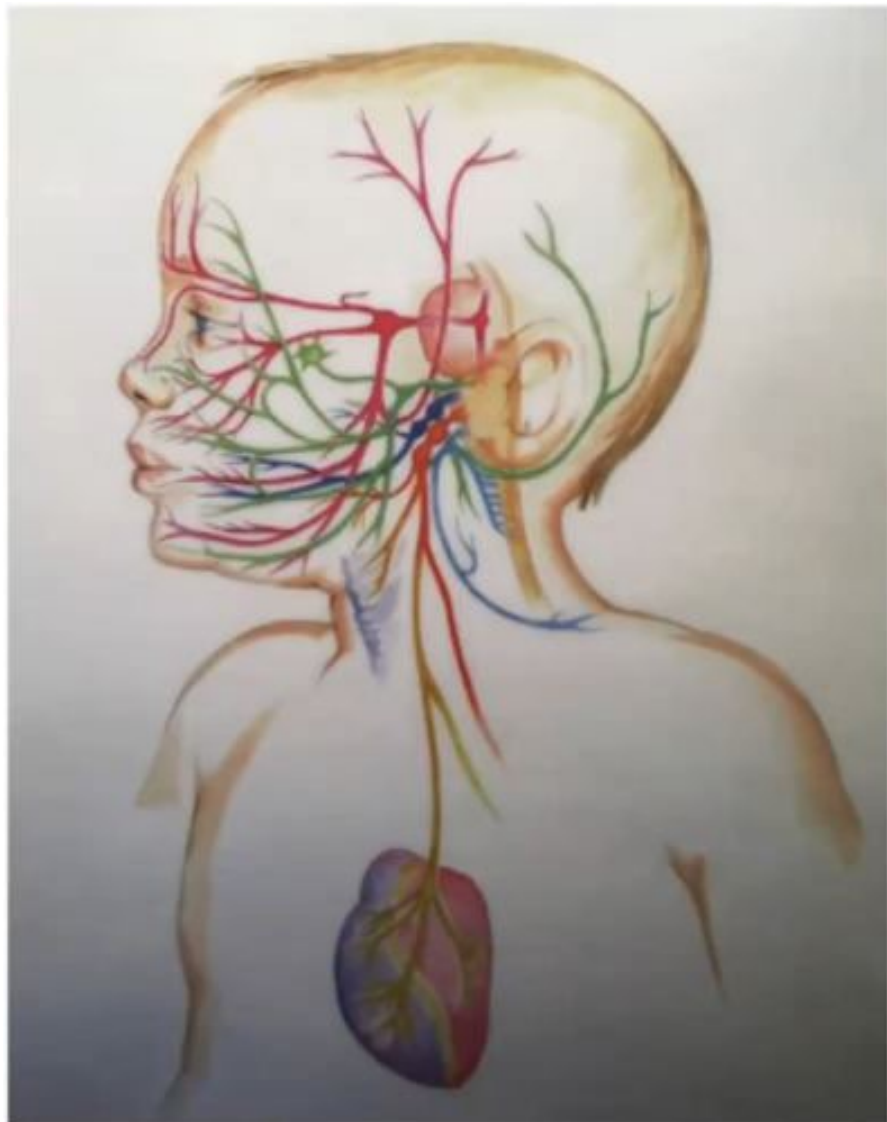

Restorative Practices For Youth Programs Training (14 Hour)



- Clarifying key distinctions of restorative approaches to facilitating accountability, addressing behavior, and promoting resilience
- Developing non-punitive and trauma-informed tools and strategies for responding to conflict and challenging behavior

Police-Youth Dialogue

- Building understanding, connection, trust, and safety between young people and law enforcement officers
- Partners include Gainesville Police Dept, Alachua County Sheriff's Office, High Springs Police Dept., and others



Youth Leadership and Conflict Resolution Program (8 Week Series)

- Building a foundation for personal growth, emotional intelligence, leadership, and the capacity to navigate interpersonal challenges effectively
- Culminates in a student-led community teach back
- Partners include Baxter's Place, W.M. Stokes Center, Pace Center for Girls - Alachua, and others
