Recommended Board Action: Motion to authorize the use of Road Impact Fund fees, in an amount not to exceed \$240,000 for the Churchill County Road Department to participate in a joint project with Truckee Carson Irrigation District to install piping on a portion of Miners Road.

Discussion: Due to high traffic and safety concerns, the Churchill County Road Department will be participating in a joint project with Truckee Carson Irrigation District (TCID) to pipe 2,400 feet of the LD Drain on Miners Road. The cost estimate is \$240,000.

It is proposed that the Road Impact Fee Fund be used for the cost of this project. The County Commissioners are authorized under the county code to make approvals for the use of this fund. The area that will be most benefited from this project is located with Service Area B as defined in the county code. This portion of the fund will be used for this project.

Alternatives: Deny

Fiscal Impact: Not to exceed \$240,000.
