Discussion: The Bureau of Land Management (BLM) provides notification of the Vegas to Reno Off-Highway Vehicle Race 2021. This race takes place on lands managed by the BLM that fall within the Tonopah, Stillwater, and Sierra Front field offices. The race is scheduled to start on August 13th near Bonnie Claire, Nevada and to finish on August 14th near Dayton, Nevada. Race officials will be controlling traffic along the race route, highway crossings, and several access roads until the last race vehicle has passed.

This event is in compliance with the BLM's mission to provide multiple use of public lands under the 1976 Federal Land Policy and Management Act and, considering permit stipulations, will cause little or no inconvenience to the area or staff. Local governments along the race route support this event to bring tourism and economic stimulus to rural areas.
