DPS Report to Town Board

As of May 28th. 2026 the Dept. has been paged out for 112 calls. 71 were EMR calls and 29 were fire calls, and 12 calls were both. This compares to 97 to date in 2025. This is an increase of 15.5% from 2025.

On May 19th, we moved into our new east side station behind Oinks. We had an auto-aid call in Fox Crossing the next day.

Chris has been busy doing sewer locates and sewer lateral installation inspections. We have taken delivery of the pickup truck that was purchased for inspections and locates has been put into service. It is nice to be able to store all the needed equipment in the truck instead of loading and unloading every time we had to borrow a truck from DPW.

Our Touch-A-Truck event is August 15th. We are planning on purchasing rope rescue equipment to update some equipment that is aging out. The new equipment is much faster and safer to set up and operate than the aging equipment.

We have two people attending an open house event at Fox Crossing FD on May 30th. This is a SOAR Fox Valley event. It will have a high sensory area with lights and sirens and a low sensory area with no lights or noises.
