DPS Report to Town Board

As of July 26<sup>th</sup>. 2023 the Dept. has been paged-out for 128 calls. Sixty-four were EMR calls and fifty were fire calls, and fourteen that were both. This compares to 144 to date in 2022.

Several members of CFR attended a three-hour training/tour with Fox Crossing and Town of Neenah at the new Neenah High School.

As part of my research on mass causality incident equipment and training, I will be observing a half day Rescue Task Force (RTF) training at the City of Neenah the week of August 7<sup>th</sup>.

CFR will be attending a training session on August 8<sup>th</sup> at the Appleton Airport. Then on August 16<sup>th</sup> several members will be taking part in the tri-annual airport exercise. I have been asked to serve as the time keeper releasing units into the exercise as they are paged.

Six members of CFR and I responded as part of the Winnebago County MABAS grass rig strike team to Coloma to help fight the recent wild fire.

This week I responded to my first call as ordinance enforcement officer to a dog at large complaint
