PURPOSE OF REPORT:				

WHAT IS BEING ASKED OF THE CITY COUNCIL/BOARD:

The City Council is being asked to hold the first reading of Ordinance No. 284-2025, amending Section 9-1 of the Clearlake Municipal Code to adopt the 2025 California Building Standards Code (CBSC), title 24, Parts 1-11A, as a result of the 2024 Triennial Code Adoption Cycle. Further, the City Council is being asked to set the second reading and adoption for the next City Council meeting on January 15, 2026.

BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION:

An information bulletin (IB) was provided by the California Department of Housing and Community Development (HCD) Division of Codes and Standards dated September 22, 2025, pursuant to the California Health and Safety Code (HSC), section 17913, to provide notice to local enforcing agencies of a code adoption. HCD's updates to these building standards apply to the design and construction of residential occupancies and their accessory structures, factory-built housing, commercial modulars, special purpose commercial modulars, and permanent buildings, accessory buildings, and structures constructed in mobile home parks and special occupancy parks.

The 2025 CBSC applies to all buildings and structures with a permit application date on or after January 1, 2026. Local jurisdictions establish the "permit application date" which will correspond to the date the applicant signs the application, it is assigned an application number in our online portal.

The building department shall retain a current copy of the CBSC available for public inspection pursuant to HSC, section 18942, subdivision (e)(1). In addition, the city shall obtain and maintain at least one copy of building standards and other state regulations relating to buildings published in titles 8, 19, 20, 24 and 25 of the California Code of Regulations (CCR). These records are kept in the office of the Building Official responsible for the administration and enforcement of state building standards.

Notice was given on November 20, 2025 to notify the public; designers, contractors and other agencies, of the update as recommended by HCD. Further notice of the public hearing was published in the Lake County Record Bee.
