BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION:		
In 2016 the City adopted a set of environmental guidelines, including Appendix O "Na Consultation Program". Historically, there have been three tribes with connections to ancestorial lands within the City of Clearlake boundaries; the Elem Indian Colony of Pomo Indians of the Sulphur Bank Rancheria, the Koi Nation of Northern California, and the Middletown Rancheria of Pomo Indians of California. While in large part consultation and coordination between the City as lead agency and the tribes has worked quite well, more recently new staff within the tribal environmental community have resulted in a inconsistent, confrontational, and difficult approach to complete projects. Staff believe that by adopting a more comprehensive policy framework related to tribal cultural resources would result in more predictability, less room for disagreement, and a more streamlined and economic project completion.		
The interim policy before you is not the more complete version that is desired, but would help in providing some framework while a more detailed policy is established with tribal involvement.
