WHAT IS BEING ASKED OF THE CITY COUNCIL/BOARD:

The City Council is being asked to Consider the Resolution No 2022-21, A Resolution of the City of Clearlake, approving a temporary street closure for the It Takes a Village 5K Run.

BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION:

It Takes a Village 5K Run is a Harvest Church Sponsored event. The event will be held on Saturday May 21, 2022. It is proposed that the roads be closed as follows:

- a) Uhl Avenue at Austin Road from 6:30am 12:00pm on the day of the event.
- b) Uhl Avenue at Olympic Drive from 6:30am 12:00on on the day of the event.

This event is hosted by the Harvest Church of Clearlake and is promoting community togetherness and wellness.

The application and permitting process includes provisions for the sponsor to assume the responsibility for placement and removal of physical barricades as per California Motor Vehicle Code Section 21103 and requires \$1,000,000 in liability insurance coverage naming the City of Clearlake additional insured, along with other insurance and indemnification provisions.
