BACKGROU	ND/DISCUS	SSION:					
On September 8 th , 2024 the City of Clearlake experienced an incident known as The Boyles Fire. In order to recover costs expended by the City in various departments during the incident period and recovery phase it is necessary to apply for and manage the request to obtain financial assistance. The State of California Cal OES office is the "recipient" of federal grant funds available for this purpose and is requiring the signing of this form OES-FPD-130 prior to funds being released to the City of Clearlake who will be the "sub-recipient". This resolution, once agreed upon, will be in effect for 3 years from the date of approval for all open and future disasters/grants declared.
