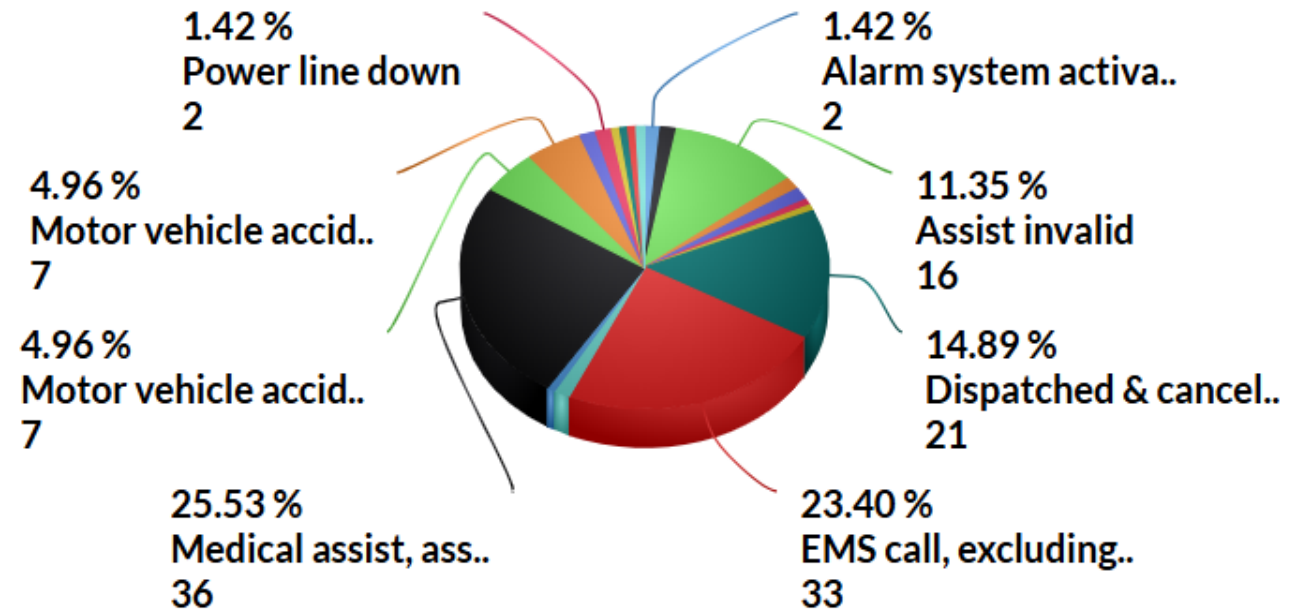

## Analysis by Detailed Incidents Type 10/01/2025-10/31/2025



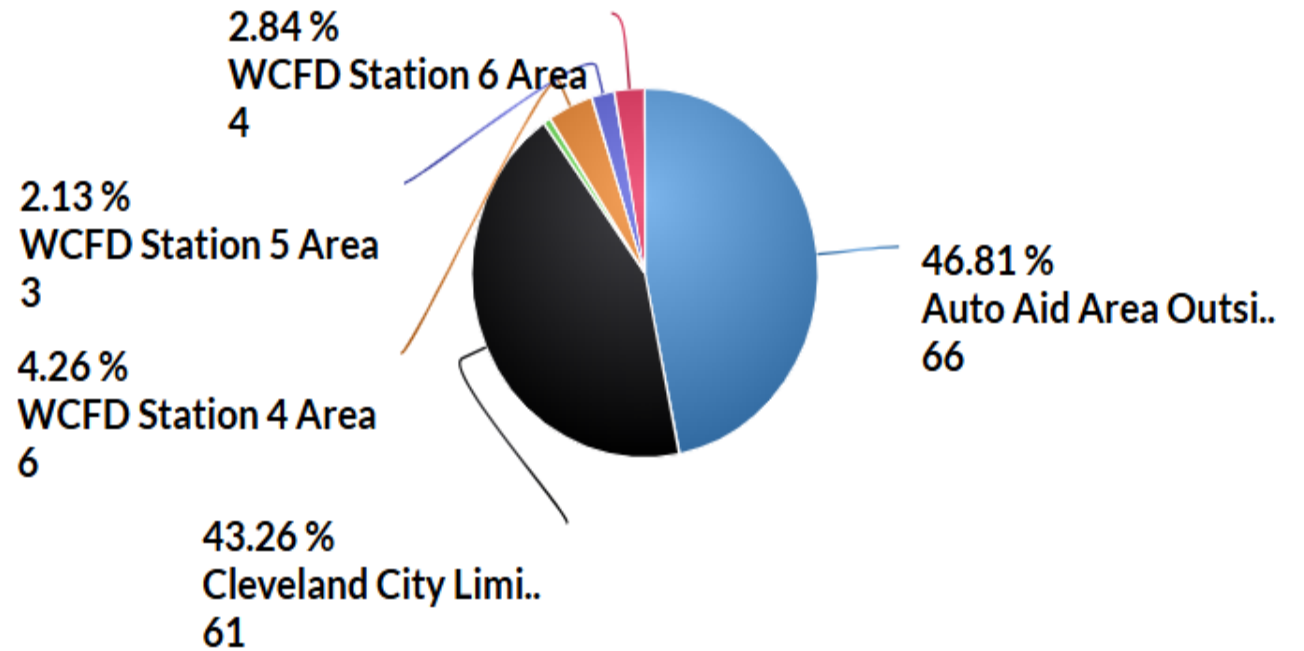

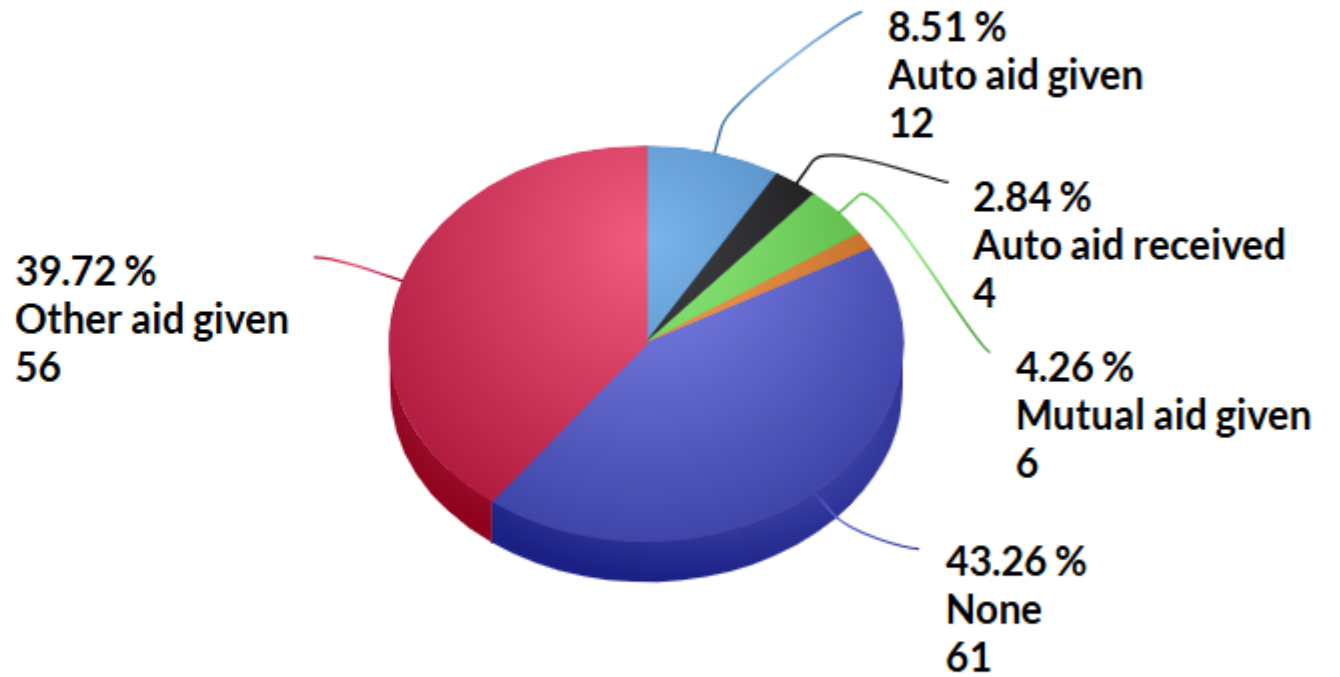
