



CITY OF CLEVELAND, GA RESOLUTION 2026-16

RESOLUTION DECLARING CERTAIN CITY-OWNED VEHICLES, EQUIPMENT, AND MISCELLANEOUS PROPERTY AS SURPLUS AND AUTHORIZING THEIR LAWFUL DISPOSITION

WHEREAS, the City of Cleveland has become more intentional with the management of its vehicle fleet, equipment, and other City-owned property; and

WHEREAS, the City is working to improve the condition and average age of its current inventory and to free space currently occupied by vehicles, equipment, and other property that is no longer necessary to serve the businesses and residents of the City of Cleveland; and

WHEREAS, certain vehicles, equipment, and miscellaneous items are no longer necessary or useful for municipal purposes and should be declared surplus so that they may be lawfully dispositioned; and

WHEREAS, the vehicles, equipment, and miscellaneous items proposed to be declared surplus are identified in **Exhibit A**, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference; and

WHEREAS, Georgia law permits personal property having an estimated value of \$500.00 or less to be disposed of without advertisement or competitive bidding when permitted by law.

WHEREAS, the City desires to dispose of surplus property in accordance with **O.C.G.A. § 36-37-6**, the City of Cleveland Code of Ordinances, and other applicable laws; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Cleveland, Georgia, that the vehicles, equipment, and miscellaneous property listed in **Exhibit A** are hereby declared to be surplus City property and are no longer necessary or useful for municipal purposes.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that surplus personal property having an estimated value of **\$500.00 or less**, including property determined to have no reasonable resale value, may be sold, recycled, scrapped, discarded, or otherwise lawfully disposed of by

the City Manager or his designee, as appropriate, without advertisement or competitive bidding when permitted by **O.C.G.A. § 36-37-6** and other applicable laws.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that personal property having an estimated value of \$500.00 or less may be disposed of without advertisement or competitive bidding when permitted by O.C.G.A. § 36-37-6 and other applicable laws.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
