STAFF RECOMMENDATION:

Approve Resolution No. 2024-38 authorizing the application submittal for the Fiscal Year 2023 Emergency Management Performance Grant (EMPG), in the amount of \$12,173.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

The County of Riverside has released its Emergency Management Performance Grant (EMPG). The identified maximum per capital allocation the City of Coachella is eligible to receive is \$12,173. This grant does require a 100% match (1 to 1 ratio), thus the total expenditures must total \$24,346 to receive the full allocation available to the City of Coachella.

Staff is recommending requesting these funds be used to recover costs for the city's annual service contract with the County of Riverside Emergency Management Department for an Emergency Services Coordinator. The recommended submittal for reimbursement of staffing expenses for the Emergency Services Coordinator will total \$12,173; this will reimburse city for County staffing expenses.

FISCAL IMPACT:

As the match amounts are already budgeted for in the current fiscal year, the recommended actions will have positive fiscal impact.
